

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# NYHAVN

Nyhavn is a harbor district in Copenhagen, which is one of the most visited tourist destinations. Nyhavn is always full of life and with good reason, the beautiful colored houses reflect in the canals and give a travel photo perfect for Instagram and memories to keep. The "Nyhavnskanalen" was inaugurated by Christian V in the 1670s, but today it's simply called Nyhavn.

Every year millions of tourist visit Nyhavn and therefore there's always interesting objects to take photos of. Nyhavn is especially beautiful in the morning, when the water is calm and the sun rises from the east side of the district.

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### THE MARBLE CHURCH

The marble church or its official name "Frederiks Kirke" is a beautiful piece of architecture located in the heart of Copenhagen. It's close to Nyhavn, King's Garden and many other attractive locations for photography. It even has its own metro station now, so you can't miss it. It's as beautiful inside as it is on the outside, however, my favorite viewing point of the church is from the tower "Christiansborg Slotstårn". The tower has free entrance and you just take an elevator to the viewing point after going through a security check point. 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# **KING'S** GARDEN




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## CHRISTIANSHAVN
